Radboud University

Nijmegen is a real student city! The city offers a lot of fun places and activities for students to go to. At first, there are a lot of, quite cheap, student bars. On nights during the week you will only find students over there.

Also, there are a lot of student associations as a hockey association, rowing, soccer, and regular student associations who's main goal is to bring people together ans celebrate your student life.

Apart from that, almost every study has their own study association. Dentistry has the TFV Nijmegen, which stands for Dentistry Faculty Association Nijmegen. The association has a board of 6 student each year, who will be responsible for organizing a lot of activities, for fun but also for education. They will do it together with their different committees, as party committee, barcommittee, introduction committee and culture committee!

Dentistry @ Radboud University

In the Netherlands the study dentistry takes 6 years. There are 3 universities that offer dentistry: Amsterdam, Groningen & Nijmegen.

In Nijmegen, the first year mainly consists of a lot of theory, and a lot of preclinics. In the second year, students already see their first patients for just simple checkups, but will still be in preclinics quite a lot. In the third year, students will start to see patients for their first fillings.

After 3 years, student finish their bachelor and will then start with 3 years of master. In the master, dentistry student work together with oral hygiene students! They form groups of approximately 15 students, who will takes care of around 800-900 patients. They are responsible for their treatments, and need to make appointments themselves. When a patient is in need of a fillings, oral hygiene students will send them to a dentistry student from their group, and when they need severe periodontic treatment, dentistry student will call in the help of oral hygiene students. In this way, students will learn to work in a regular dental clinic.

Dentistry @ Radboud University

Besides the time at the clinic in the faculty, students will also follow several internships during their masters. They will work in a dental clinic somewhere in the country for a few weeks, they will follow an internship at oral surgery in the hospital, and they will follow an internship at a nursing home.

At last, students can choose a part of dentistry which they are particularly interested in, such as periodontal surgery, endodontics or reconstructive dentsitry. They will see patients who are in need of complicated treatments in that part of dentistry once a week for about a year.



Dentistry @ The Netherlands

In The Netherlands, most dentists work in group practices. Years ago, it was common for dentists to just work in a little practice located at their houses, but nowadays this totalle changed. The ideal situation for dentists is to work in practice with oral hygienists, and dentists with interests in different part of dentistry, such as an endodontist, a periodontologist and a cosmetic dentist.

In our country, prices for treatments are set by the government. Dentists can therefore not set prices themselves, which can make it hard to put a lot if time and effort into a esthetic restoration..

The costs for dental treatments are not covered by basic insurance, so people need to just pay the costs or choose to pay for additional insurance monthly. Patients don't get a set guarantee at certain treatments, this is something the dentist can decide himself.

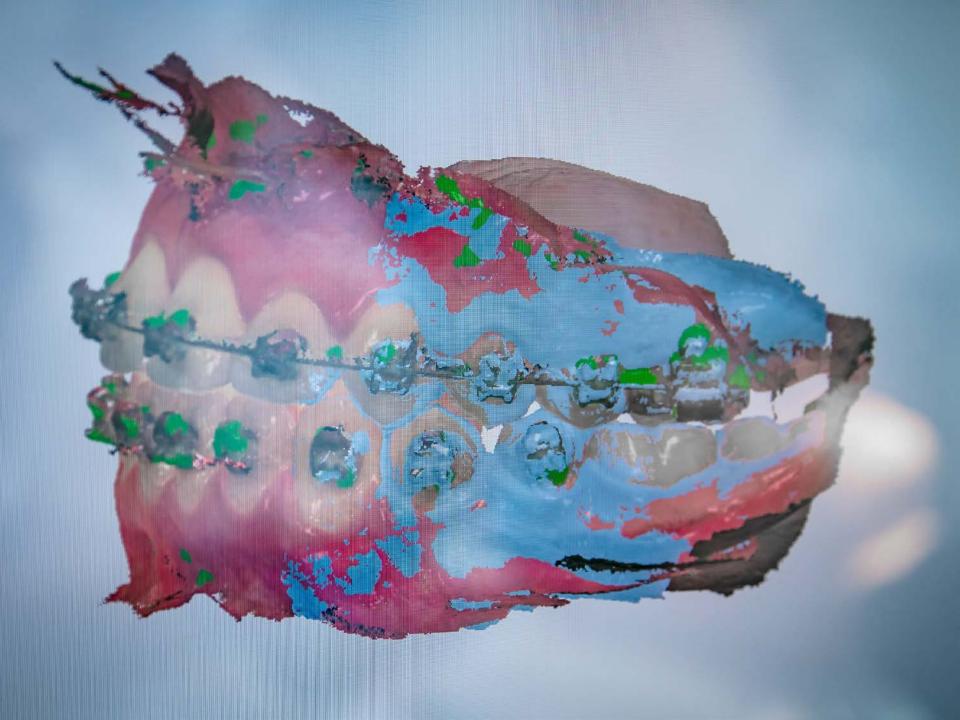
