Management of needlestick and similiar injuries

THE STUDENT

Should immediately:

Wash and disinfect according to protocol

Thereafter:

- Contact your supervisor.
- Contact Student Wellbeing Centre +46(0)8-524 835 70
- Submit completed <u>needlestick injury report</u> (stick-/skärskadejournal) to Student Wellbeing Centre.
- KI-stident report the injury in <u>the KI incident reporting system</u> Student at another higher education institution – contact your programme coordinator.

THE SUPERVISOR/TEACHING STAFF

- Initiates risk assessment with support of attending physician in the clinic.
- Ensures that Student Wellbeing Centre receives de-identified test results on source patient* (via needlestick injury report).

*Source patient (index patient): current individual who may be the source of infection
